- Henry Charles Hill** 23 years - Victoria Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Royal Navy - Killed (air raid) Chatham September 3rd 1917 - Buried in Gillingham Naval Plot, Kent.
- Ernest Brown** 22 years - Northfield Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Royal West Surrey Regt - Killed October 24th 1916 - No known grave. Commemorated at Tyne-Cot memorial Ypres.
- Harry Quarterman** 35 years - Northfield Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Royal Berkshire Regt - Died as POW October 30th 1918 - Buried in Sedan (St Charles) Communal Cemetery, France.
- James John Newell** 20 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Life Guards Household Battn - Killed April 11th 1917 At Battle of the Scarpe - Buried in Athies Communal Cemetery, France.
- Thomas Arthur Bryant** 20 years - Victoria Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Royal Berkshire Regt - Killed November 10/11 1914 Ypres - Buried Fauquissart Cemetery.
- Fred Colbourne** 30 years - Victoria Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Machine Gun boy - Died in training (17 days Service) UK - Buried in Eton Wick churchyard.
- Albert Stallwood** 26 Years - Victoria Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Guards Machine Guns Regt (Trooper) - October 24th 1918 France - Buried Prémont British Cemetery (Nr. St. Quentin) France.
- Arthur Thomas Iremonger** 27 years - Eton Wick Road, Boveney N/T - Single - Royal Berkshire Regt - Fought Loos, believed killed 1917 - Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, France.
- Frank Church** 29 years - Eton Wick Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Royal Berkshire RGT - Killed July 19th 1916 Somme, France - Buried in Laventie Cemetery, Armentières, France.
- Henry George Moss** 27 years - Moores Lane, Boveney Newtown - Single - Royal Army Service Corp- Transport - Died Influenza October 21st 1918 - Buried in Roisel Communal Cemetery, France.
- George Edward Bolton** 26 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Oxfordshire and Bucks Light infantry - Killed September 1915 - Buried in Guards Cemetery, Windy Corner, Guinchy, France.
- Alfred Brown** 34 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Grenadier Guards - Killed July 31st 1917 Passchendaele, Belgium
- Angus Bruce (DCM)** 37 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Highland Light Infantry - Killed March 1918 Arras Area - No known grave, commemorated on Arras Memorial, France.
- Arthur Bunce** 21 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Single - Worcestershire Regt - Killed June 7th 1917 Messines S Ypres - Buried in Messines Ridge Cemetery, Belgium.
- Horace Charles Dobson** 29 years - Alma Road, Boveney Newtown - Married - Duke of Wellington Regt - Died illness July 15th 1918 Leeds - Buried in Eton Wick churchyard.
- Albert John Caesar** (Mid 30s) - Alma Road, Eton Wick - Married - Grenadier Guards - Killed September 1st 1914 - Buried in Villers Cotterêts Forest Cemetery, France.
- Cyril Arthur Ashman** 20 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - The Honourable Artillery Company - Killed Ghelouelt Cypress October 26th 1917 - Buried Tyne-cot Cemetery.
- Henry Douglas Ashman** 23 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - Berkshire Yeoman - Killed August 1915 Gallipoli
- Robert Thomas Hobrough MM** 37 years - The Walk, Eton Wick - Married - Royal Engineers - Signals - Killed Passchendaele, September 30th 1917 - Commemorated at Tyne-Cot memorial, Belgium.
- Charles Miles** 20 years - The Walk, Eton Wick - Single - Royal Navy - HMS Vanguard Killed Scapa-Flow July 9th 1917 - Commemorated on Chatham Naval Memorial. Kent.
- George Frederick Percy** 19 years - Sheepcote Road, Eton Wick - Single - Royal Warwickshire Regt - Killed April 15th 1918 La Bassee, Belgium - No grave known. Commemorated Ploesgteert Memorial, Belgium.
- Joseph Newell** 24 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - Oxfordshire and Bucks Light Infantry - Died as POW in Turkey April to May 1916 - Commemorated on Basra Memorial, Iraq.
- Arthur Richards/Richardson** 26 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - South Wales Borderers - Killed May 2nd 1915 Gallipoli - No known grave. Commemorated on the Helles Memorial.
- Isaac Springford** 21 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - Royal Garrison Artillery - Died by Gas July 2nd 1918, Kent - Buried Eton Wick churchyard.
- Joseph Springford** 30 years - Common Road, Eton Wick - Single - Sherwood Foresters - Died in hospital February 15th 1918 Rouen - Buried in St Sever Cemetery, France.
- George Peter Baldwin** 36 years - Common Road, Eton-Wick - Married - Royal Berkshire Regt - Killed April 24th 1918 Somme - Buried Hangard Wood Cemetery. France.
- Frederick Thomas Buckland** 23 years - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Single - Queens Royal West Surrey Regt - Died of Sickness, December 23rd 1914 - No headstone, buried Eton Wick.
- John Carfrae Clark** 19 years - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Single - Royal Field Artillery - Killed April 23rd 1917 - Buried in Anzin-St-Aubin Cemetery, Arras, France.
- Charles Fountain-Ralph Godwin** Mid 20s - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Married - Life Guards - Killed (air raid) Étaples May 19th 1918 - Buried in Étaples Military Cemetery, France.
- Charles William Hammerton** 22 years - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Single - Queen Victoria Rifles - Killed at Transley Ridge October 9th 1918 - No known grave. Commemorated Thiepval Memorial, France.
- Ernest Jordan** 32 years - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Single - Royal Engineers & Signals - Died illness August 1916 - Buried in Amara War Cemetery, Iraq.
- Walter William Payne** 22 years - Eton Wick Road, Eton Wick - Single - The Royal Scots-Lothian Regt - Killed March 12th 1916, France - Buried in Rifle Cemetery, Ploegsteert Wood, France.
- Herbert Pithers** Late 30s - Little Common, Eton Wick - Married - Oxfordshire and Bucks Light Infantry - Killed February 28th 1917 Somme - No known grave. Commemorated on Thiepval Memorial, France.
- Peter Leo Knight/Knight** 27 years - Meadow Lane, Eton - Married - Royal Field Artillery - Drowned October 26th 1915 Aegean Sea - No grave. Commemorated on Mikra Memorial. Salonika, Greece.
