Environment Committee

Draft Terms of Reference:

The intention is that the Environment Committee will be active in its role of monitoring the local environment, and that it will visit many of the areas listed below from time to time and as and when appropriate. In particular, the committee will:

1. oversee the Council's recreation grounds, play areas, green spaces, trees and flower beds and suggest improvements
2. consider proposals for maintaining and, where possible, promoting biodiversity and promoting natural capital in the parish
3. monitor the condition of the football pitches at Haywards Mead Recreation Ground and in liaison with Eton Wick Football and Social Club, suggest improvements
4. monitor the condition of the football pitches at South Meadow Lane Recreation Ground in liaison with Eton College and suggest improvements
5. monitor the state of local waterways and, liaising with Eton Wick Waterways Group and other stakeholders, propose the work necessary for the Council to meet its responsibilities as a riparian owner
6. monitor the efficacy of the Council's services regarding litter control and dog bins and suggest improvements
7. review local pollution levels according to data gathered by, e.g. RBWM (air) and EWWG (water)
8. monitor and report upon RBWM footpaths
9. monitor and report upon RBWM verge and tree maintenance
